

Photographer/Videographer Information

Welcome to St. Monica Catholic Church. The following are guidelines we have adopted in regard to photographs and videos to be taken during weddings celebrated in our Church. We ask for your cooperation. If you have any questions or concerns, please discuss them with the Wedding Coordinator assigned to your wedding.

1. All photo/video work must be done with the available light. Our electrical system has been updated and is more than adequate. No flood, strobe or spotlights are permitted.
2. No flash photography is allowed during the ceremony. You may use a flash for the seating of parents, the Processional (the entrance of the bridal party and bride), and the Recessional (the bride and groom exiting the church).
3. Posed pictures are never allowed in the church before or after the ceremony. There are no exceptions to this rule. There are areas around the church that are available (e.g., the front lawn of the Rectory, along the side of the church on 7th Street and the Duval Patio).
4. Video camera (without floodlights) is permitted only in certain areas. Check with the Priest and Wedding Coordinator the day of the wedding. If additional wireless microphones are used, they must be at a frequency below 554 MHz or above 590 MHz. An audio “press feed” is available on the column next to the grand piano. It accepts an XLR female plug.
5. All photographers and videographers must check in with the Wedding Coordinator prior to the ceremony to receive any specific requirements of the Priest.
6. At no time are you allowed to rearrange the furniture in the church.
7. You are responsible for the security and removal of all your equipment.
